


Squirrel Class: Year 2 - Home Learning Grid: Autumn 2

<p><u>Geography:</u> What are the four countries that make up the United Kingdom? Make a list and then choose one of them and write a fact file about some of the most well-known physical features (eg The River Thames, Giant's Causeway, Mount Snowdon) found there.</p>  <p>Parent/carer Signature.....</p>	<p><u>Reading:</u> Choose a favourite book of yours and write a book review. Tell us what it is about, who the author is, why you like it and who you might recommend it to.</p>  <p>Parent/carer Signature.....</p>	<p><u>Science:</u> What kind of materials are used in your kitchen and your living room? Can you use addition <u>and</u> subtraction equations? Can you find more than 15 ways?!
