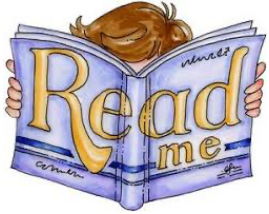
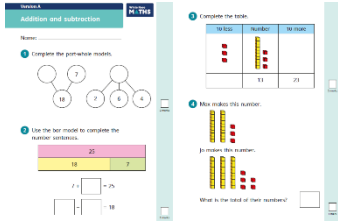


Squirrel Class: Year 2 - Home Learning Grid: Autumn 2

Make a list and then choose one of them and write a fact file about some of the most well-known physical features (eg The River Thames, Giant's Causeway, Mount Snowdon) found there.
