Maths

Fractions: The children will begin this block by exploring the denominators of unit fractions. From Year 2, they know about halves, guarters and thirds and they will now look at fractions with other denominators. They will grow to understand that a fraction can be seen as part of a whole and that to find a unit fraction, they divide the whole into equal parts.

Mass and Capacity: in this block the children will learn to use and understand scales. This small step provides opportunity for the children to become more familiar with using scales to read measurements.
