The whole of the Primary Phase had lots of fun today during their Urban Strides dance workshop. Make sure you ask the children to show you their funky moves!



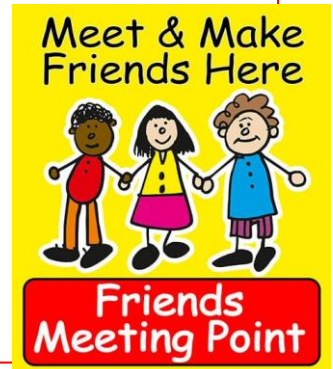
