The social event of the year took place on Wednesday – THE SCHOOL DISCO! There were bubbles, dance-offs, snacks and medals. The children had a blast!




The community that collected most points this term is **Salisbury**. They will meet with Mrs Palmer next term to decide what their prize is going to be!


